#### **Summer Registration**

Registration is only required if:

- your child is new to Halifax Regional Centre for Education (HRCE),
- you have moved and your child will be attending a new school in HRCE
- your child is beginning school in pre-primary or primary.

Students currently enrolled in Pre-Primary that are going into primary next year are not required to re-register for primary unless you are opting for French Immersion in which case you must register with SJAM.
