This will give our primary students and families a chance to briefly meet the teacher before school starts.

Grade 1-6 Class Lists (How will you find out who is teaching your child?)

On Tuesday afternoon, Sept. 5th PD day, **Grade 1-6** parents will receive an email from their child's teacher welcoming them to that class. Details such as what entry door they are to use on Sept. 7th will be included in the email.

A Word About Class Lists

Much time goes into the making of class lists in June. Student learning profiles, social networks, needs, staffing etc. are all considerations when creating class lists for the following year. Among all the happy and excited students, there are always a few who feel let down. Please know that every effort is made to accommodate requests but ultimately, we can't honour all of them. Therefore, we will not be considering any requests for class changes until the end of September when our enrollment numbers are finalized. It is also important to know that due to class caps, any such moves generally require a child to move out of the other class.
